Popping to the shops?

Thinking of going Christmas shopping? Its important to think about how you will be travelling to the shops. Could you walk or cycle rather than drive? Office for National Statistics (ONS) Data suggests that 40% of urban journeys are under 2 miles. Replacing this by walking or cycling could burn between 150 to 250 calories which could significantly add up as time goes on. Replacing short car journeys by walking or cycling benefits both you and the environment, so everyone benefits.







There are various family friendly events in the local area to participate in, with a small selection detailed below. They offer a great way of meeting other people in Beckenham, as well as a place to improve fitness.

Beckenham Place Park Walk

Situated just 2 miles from your new home, the Beckenham Place Park Walk is an easy route for you and your family.

This route takes you along the beautiful Ravensbourne River, where you can take in plenty of winter scenery.

The newly— opened Beckenham Park offers beautiful natural scenery to be enjoyed from its dedicated Nature Trail. The redesigned Park opened in 2019, and features protected historic woodland, a swimming lake, children's' playground, running track, cycle track, and café.

Car parking is available on site, where there is a pay and display machine in place. Electric vehicle charging is also provided. Excellent public transport links means the park is easily accessible via bus or train.

The number 358 service is accessible via stops located on South Eden Park Road and The Chinese Garage, approximately a 2 minute walk from your home. There are direct bus services half hourly to Crystal Palace and Orpington Bus Station Monday to Saturday, and half hourly on Sundays.
